Efficiency evaluation based on cost-effectiveness analysis has been introduced into the system for decision-making to support stable provision of medical services. In recent years, concerns over widening health disparities and the growing debate over sustainability have led to the need for medical technology evaluations that are based on various value axes such as equity, budgetary impact, and labor productivity impact, in addition to efficiency. Especially in the evaluation of prevention and health promotion services aimed at extending healthy life expectancy, the consideration of multifaceted evaluation axes is indispensable and an issue to be overcome. In order to respond to these social demands, this research project aims to propose a new system of service evaluation in line with the value consciousness of the SDGs by mobilizing relevant researchers of the Japan Health Economics Association. We would like to report on the interim results of this project and provide an opportunity to seek broad opinions from the floor, not limiting ourselves to academic discussions.
